Thanks for your enquiry about a community stall at the Otago Farmers Market. Here is a list of all the things you need to know about operating at the market and setting up your community stall.

- The community stall is only available once per group, per year.
- You have to provide everything you need - table, chairs, and shelter etc. (when you are thinking about what you need don't forget things like tie-downs for you gazebo)
- Please be aware that you are not permitted to sell anything at your community stall which is in competition with our vendors such as; home baking, vegetables, meat, plants, etc.
- We recommend if you are selling things for fundraising to try products that match the ideals of an authentic farmers market; beeswax wraps, fabric produce bags, raffles using market products, etc.
- If you need to bring in a vehicle to deposit your gear, you will need to be there by 7am. There is no vehicular movement allowed at the market between then and 12.30pm.
- The market is usually busy meaning the community stall has to fit where there is a space and you won't know until the morning of the market where that will be.
- We ask you to engage the public from within your stall area, not to disrupt the flow of traffic, hawk and yell out to people, or give handouts throughout the market.
